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The Ultimate Journey to the Jade Sea

This will be an emotional crescendo of your time in Kenya, as you set off on a breathtaking helicopter adventure, which has been described by many as the best day of their lives.

Depart at 7:30 a.m. in a doors-off helicopter into the heart of the Suguta Valley, a landscape that feels like an alien world. Our experienced pilots will guide you for a full day of exploring the raw untamed beauty of this remote region, offering a glimpse into land shaped by powerful geological forces, untouched by time and teeming with awe-inspiring natural wonders. Witness the towering craters of Mt. Silali, remnants of ancient volcanic fury, the incredible canvas of painted valleys, lush riverbeds, and giant sand dunes. You will fly with thousands of flamingos over Lake Logipi, see hundreds of crocodiles in their natural habitat, swim in a natural rock pool in the heart of a canyon, jump down towering sand dunes, and land on the edge of an ancient crater before soaring above the Jade Sea, where the emerald waters of Lake Turkana contrast with the surrounding arid desert.

After a picnic lunch in our hidden gem - Kampi Andrew - on South Island, spend the afternoon fishing for Nile perch - the Jade Sea Giants - and exploring the island by boat, before returning to your lodge in time for a sundowner. The perfect end to a perfect day.

This flight can be done as an overnight with prior booking.



The Journey to the Jade Sea

This is our signature trip and most popular day flight!

You will leave at 7:30 a.m. in a doors-off helicopter to embark on a journey that will undoubtedly be one of the best days of your life and what The Wall Street Journal has described as an “otherworldly helicopter experience.” The journey takes you up the incredible Suguta Valley through vast, remote, and unspoiled areas of Kenya that only a lucky few will ever see.

Our experienced pilots will guide you over an ever-changing and transforming landscape, skirting over meandering riverbeds, painted valleys, and ancient craters. You will fly with thousands of flamingoes over Lake Logipi, take a running leap down giant and surreal sand dunes, land atop extinct volcanoes, and picnic in the heart of a canyon, finally arriving at the majestic Jade Sea that is Lake Turkana—“the Cradle of Mankind”—for a swim, some bubbles, and a picnic lunch. You will arrive back at your lodge between 3 and 4 p.m.

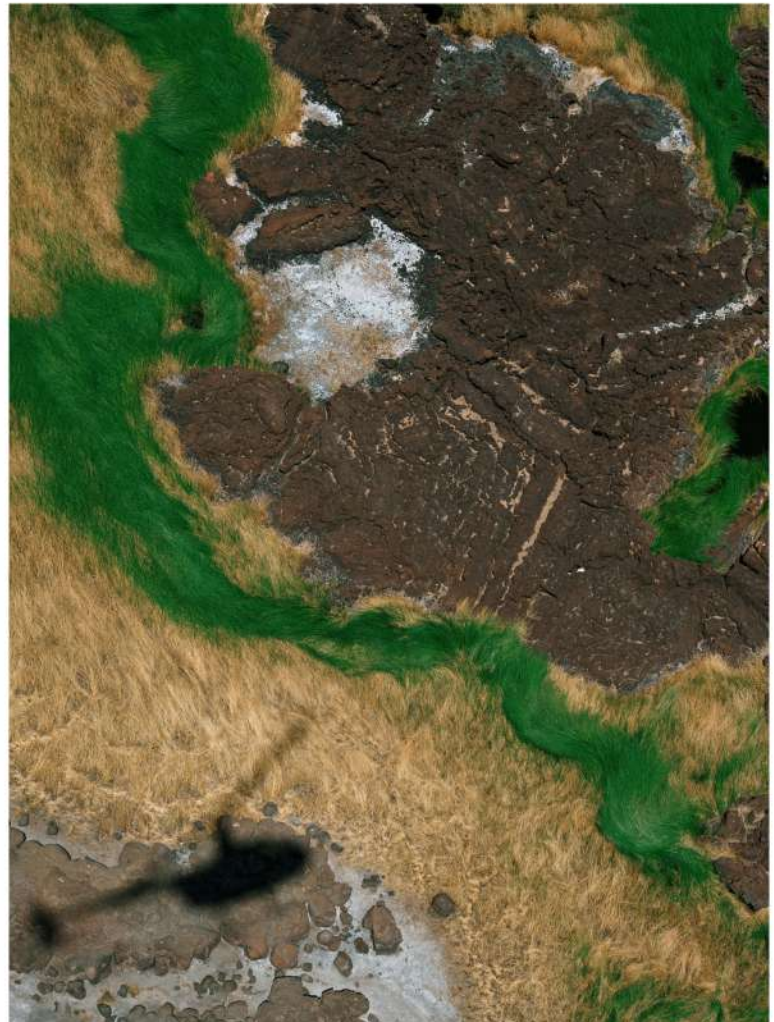
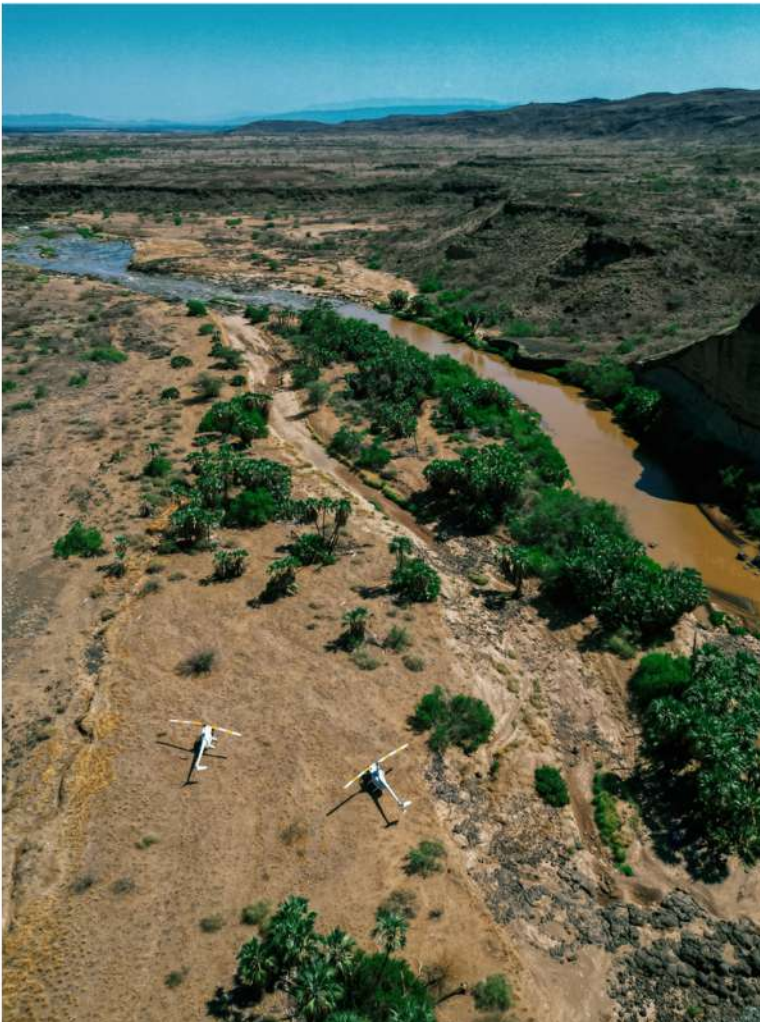




Half day Suguta Scenic

Leave at 7:30 a.m. to experience an unforgettable helicopter adventure exploring the Southern end of the Suguta Valley, an ever-changing ecosystem of ancient volcanoes, incredible valleys, and pristine natural springs. Stop for tea and coffee on the edge of a giant caldera—Mt. Silali—before heading north past lakes of soaring flamingos and natural crocodile pools. Watch the ever-changing landscape unfold beneath you in a tapestry of colors and shapes.

Along the journey, you will swim in natural springs created by lava rock, breakfast on a riverbank under palm trees, marvel at the untouched landscapes and wildlife of this remote wilderness in your doors-off helicopter, before making your way back to your lodge in time for lunch.



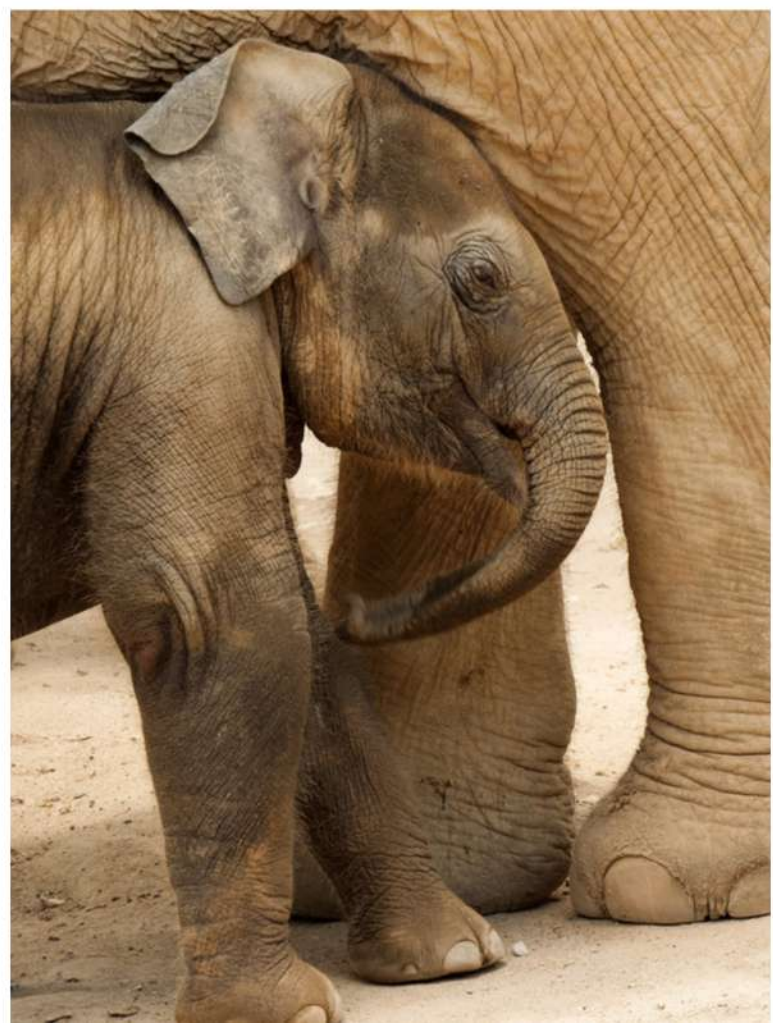


Reteti Elephant Sanctuary Scenic

This unforgettable excursion offers a perfect blend of adventure and tranquility, culminating in a sunset toast with your favorite drink and homemade appetizers on top of a natural rock kopje, offering 360-degree views of the awe-inspiring unspoiled beauty of Samburuland. Return to your lodge approximately 6:15 PM. ** Times may be earlier depending on where you are flying out of and back to.

ROBINSON R44 RAVEN II

Our Robinson R44 Raven II helicopter is capable of carrying 2 passengers plus a pilot (dependent on the weight of the passengers). Perfect for a couple.

ROBINSON R66

Our two Robinson R66 helicopters are 4 passenger, Rolls Royce powered turbine helicopters offering the same sweeping visibility as the R44, with the added fuel range and passenger capacity. Perfect for a family of 4.

These are the ultimate adventure aircraft, offering every passenger uninterrupted views. The unique doors-off experience is perfect for photographers and sightseers alike, creating the ultimate bucket list experience. Our aircraft are maintained to the highest safety standards by a KCAA-approved and licensed facility, whose engineers are trained by the helicopter manufacturer. All passengers will be given a thorough safety briefing prior to their flight.

Our helicopters are positioned at Ol Malo, an ideal location for trips from any area or lodge in the North of Kenya—from short and magical sundowner flights across Samburuland to full-day and overnight excursions into the northern wilderness and the furthest reaches of Kenya. 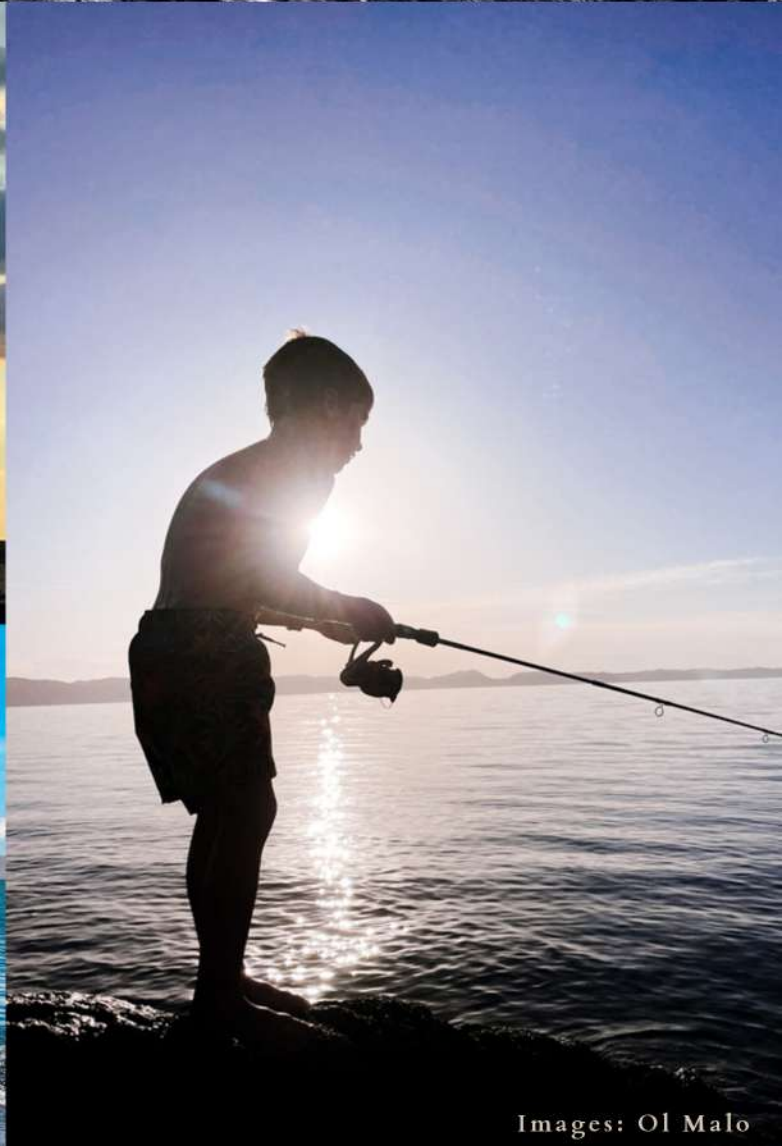
